

## Instruction for Suppliers – Lead Times for Transport Scheduling

To ensure reliable and efficient transport planning, the following binding lead times apply with immediate effect for all deliveries. These lead times are based on the dimensions of the goods to be transported. Suppliers are required to submit transport notifications in due time so that permits, vehicle scheduling, and route planning can be carried out adequately in advance.

The following lead times are mandatory:

### 1. Lead Times Based on Transport Width

Width up to 240 cm

- Lead time: 3 working days
- Note: Standard scheduling without special permits

Width 241 cm to 299 cm

- Lead time: 5 working days
- Special note: Use of permanent permit up to 3.00 m
- Vehicle: Special vehicle required

Width over 300 cm

- Lead time: 4 weeks
- Reason: Application for an individual oversize permit
- Duration depends on: Exact dimensions and destination region

### 2. Lead Times Based on Transport Height

Height up to 260 cm

- Lead time: 3 working days
- Note: Standard transport

Height up to 300 cm

- Lead time: 5 working days
- Special note: No permit required, but a special vehicle must be used

Height over 300 cm

- Lead time: 4 weeks
- Reason: Permit requirement or use of special vehicle types (e.g., low-bed trailer)

### 3. General Notes

- Lead times begin upon complete receipt of all relevant transport information (dimensions, weight, loading/unloading locations, desired date, special requirements)
- Incomplete or delayed notifications may lead to scheduling delays
- Suppliers are required to immediately report any deviations or changes
- Transport is considered scheduled only after written confirmation from our dispatching department
